JOB SUMMARY

The candidate must be a certified athletic trainer who can oversee the development and implementation of an athletic training program of the Spartans Drum and Bugle Corps. The candidate will serve as an athletic trainer in a performing arts setting, providing specialized injury prevention, immediate, and rehabilitative care to high school and college-aged musicians and color guard members. He or she will be involved in ongoing therapeutic measures to keep the members performing at their highest level. The candidate will need to manage the daily workload of up to 150 athletes and may be teamed with a supporting intern or interns. In addition to the care provided, the candidate will document all medical interactions and advise the corps director on the status and recommendations for member health. This position requires an all-day attention to job duties throughout the entire tour. Housing and board are provided according to standard provisions of drum corps tours. Schedule will vary depending on needs and time of year.

MAJOR RESPONSIBILITIES (May included, but not limited to:)

- Evaluate, manage, and treat various injuries and medical ailments
- Maintain appropriate records
- In conjunction with instructional staff, provide input on an exercise program conducive to limiting injuries
- Coordinate with other corps medical staff, as needed
- Report concerns to an administrator in a professional and timely manner
- Maintain necessary medical supply inventory within appropriated budget
- Other duties as assigned

- Master's degree preferred
- Licensure/Certification as an Athletic Trainer in the State of New Hampshire or able to obtain
- Able to be highly confidential
- Must perform assigned functions with limited or no supervision
- Must be highly organized and detail oriented
- Ability to pass CORI and Fingerprinting Check
